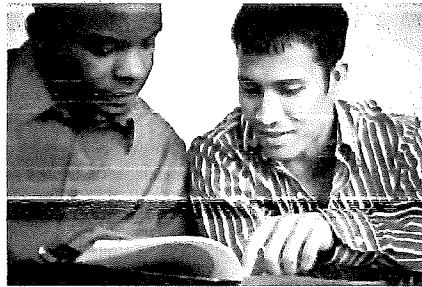


How to sign up for

Tutor Ready Reading and Writing



1. Go to the Learner Web Portal at: tutorready.learnerweb.org
2. Click on Create an Account.
3. Create a screen name, enter and confirm a password and check the "Terms of Service" box.
4. Update Your Profile by entering your first and last name and email address.

These resources focus on topics relevant to adult literacy tutoring in the areas of reading and writing. They provide answers to some common questions volunteer tutors ask about how best to help their learners improve their skills in all aspects of writing and the following components of reading:

- Comprehension
