a) Facilities

- 1) South Davis Branch Library (Walnut Park Library) Updates
  - Public Information Session on November 15, 2023
    - Flyers were sent out in the Davis utility bills.
    - The Library is also sending targeted emails to Davis library card holders.
- 2) Central Services roof is being repaired this month.
- 3) Yolo Branch AV system has been delayed until February/March 2024. The decision was made in conjunction with branch staff and the County IT department to wait for the delayed product instead of temporarily substituting something else.
- 4) Stephens-Davis Branch parking lot getting directional arrows painted and speed bumps installed.
- 5) At the next meeting, Dana will provide an update on the status of the Stephens-Davis landscaping proposals from UCD design students.
