5. County Librarian's Report

- Walnut Park Library updates – Measure T kickoff happened, many attendees. The public art deadline has past, there are at least 22 submissions.
- Staffing Update
 - i) Areli Duran-Rodriguez has been hired as our ESL Coordinator (.75 FTE, limited term)
 - ii) Davis Library has a full-time Library Assistant vacancy, first interviews were August 6
 - iii) Library Regional Manager position will be reposted soon
 - iv) New recruitment has started a Graphics Designer to help with flyers, social media and other needs
- Program updates – Summer Reading Program ends August 15
- Bookmobile update – Air bags and seat belts were fixed. Working on establishing the routes
- Budget update – In regards to the State Library cuts, BrainFuse was cut, but it was not being used, there were a number of other cuts. Parks Passes got saved
- LAB vacancies – District 1 & 2 are still vacant, but there has been an application for District 2. Diana will contact District 1 again to remind them of the vacancy
