Jug with Three Brushes
Annie Blowers 1895

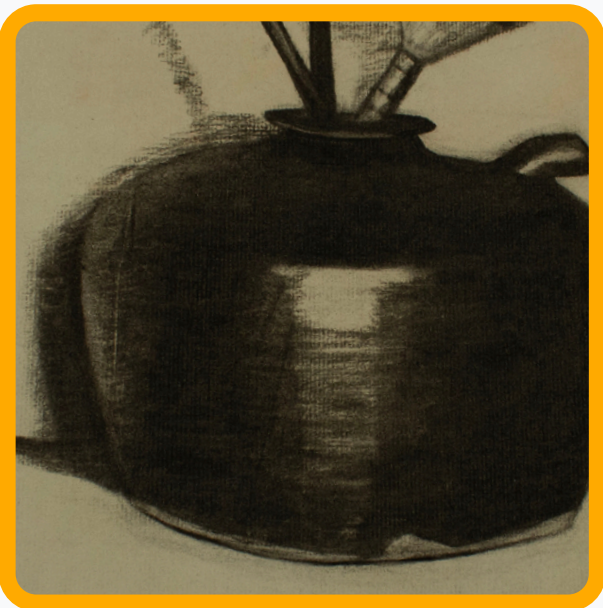
This drawing was done by Annie Blowers, a member of the Blowers family, in 1895. Annie and her sister, Carrie, were prolific artists who created many works which illustrate their passion of botany and portraiture.

Russell Blowers, born in Ohio, came to California in 1851 looking for gold like many mid-west prospectors. When he did not find gold, he took to farming. Russell grew muscatel grapes on the land that is now the Yolo County Fairgrounds.



While Mr. Blowers was highly regarded in the agricultural community, his daughters Annie and Carrie Blowers were known for their artistic talents. After their father's death in 1912, the sisters took over the operations of the Blowers farm for the next 30 years while continuing to draw inspiration from the landscape of Yolo County for their artistic practice.

Both Annie and Carrie attended Mills College where they continued to learn more about the science behind farming. Their school work, in the Yolo County Historical Collection, shows their passion for subjects like botany, advanced mathematics, and scientific illustration. See this drawing @ the Gibson House!
