NOTICE OF POSSIBLE TAX EXEMPTION FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 1989-1 (DAVIS BRANCH LIBRARY)

In November 2024, Davis voters approved Measure T, which increased the special tax for the Yolo County Library to \$175.66 annually for single family residences and \$87.83 per unit annually for multiple family residences, with a 2% cost of living escalation each year. The special tax was first implemented in 1989. Measure T will enable the county to maintain and operate the Mary L. Stephens and Walnut Park Libraries in Davis. A full exemption from the special tax is available to property owned and occupied by persons of low income.

In order to qualify for the low income exemption for the 2026-27 tax year you must, by June 1, 2026:

1. Complete and return the enclosed "Application for Low Income Special Tax Exemption" form;
2. Provide verification of income using either the enclosed "2026 Low Income Exemption Application" or submitting a copy of your 2025 income tax return.

No additional documentation providing proof of ownership is required.
